### THE PARIS AGREEMENT

An agreement within the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, dealing with greenhouse-gas-emissions mitigation, adaptation, and finance. In 2015, leaders from nearly every nation met in Paris with the goal of limiting the damaging consequences of global warming. 195 nations agreed that efforts should be made to keep the planet's warming limited to a 1.5-degree-Celsius rise in the hope of staving off the impacts of historic rainfall events, mega-droughts, and the melting of colossal ice sheets. The U.S. is the only country opposed to the agreement, with President Trump announcing he'd withdraw from the accord in 2017.

### URGENCY:

If emissions continue to rise at current rates, we have roughly a decade before we pass the 1.5°C tipping point and face climate breakdown. This will cause mass extinctions of wildlife and devastation to humanity.


We need to implement rapid, far-reaching and unprecedented changes to keep the Earth's temperature from rising.

This is the conclusion of The United Nation's Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) 2018 Report. It is also the conclusion of numerous other scientific associations.

Individual actions are important but must be combined with larger structural changes. More than anything else we need to make the 2020 elections about climate change.





Approximately 10 percent of U.S. energy use goes into growing, processing, packaging, and shipping food—about 40 percent of which just winds up in the landfill.
